

## 3. Webinar hosted by NCERT on "Virtual Labs for Languages"

## 6. Webinar titled "Virtual Labs for Social Science", organized by NCERT




## 7. Webinars "Assessment in Biology" organized by the DPS Human Resource Development Centre.
