1. Gurudwara Visit | Classes LKG–II (10 November 2025)




2. DPS–HRDC Professional Development for Faculty–Webinars (13–14 November 2025)

Webinar on “Ratio Analysis: A Case Study Perspective & Practical Insights into Financial Statement Analysis Through Cases”


